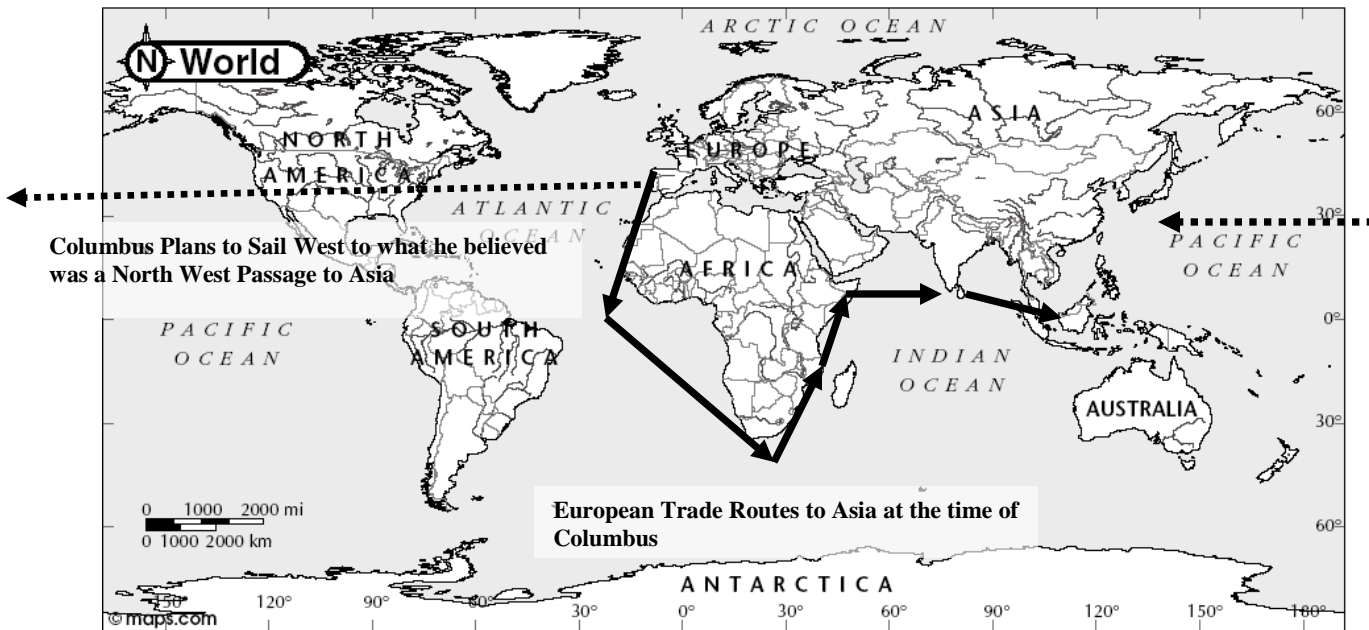


Review packet I European Exploration and Colonization

In North America the British, French and Dutch all established c_____.

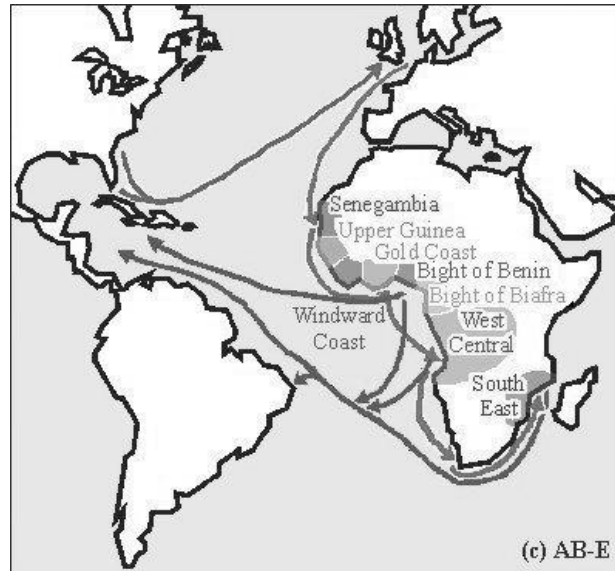
