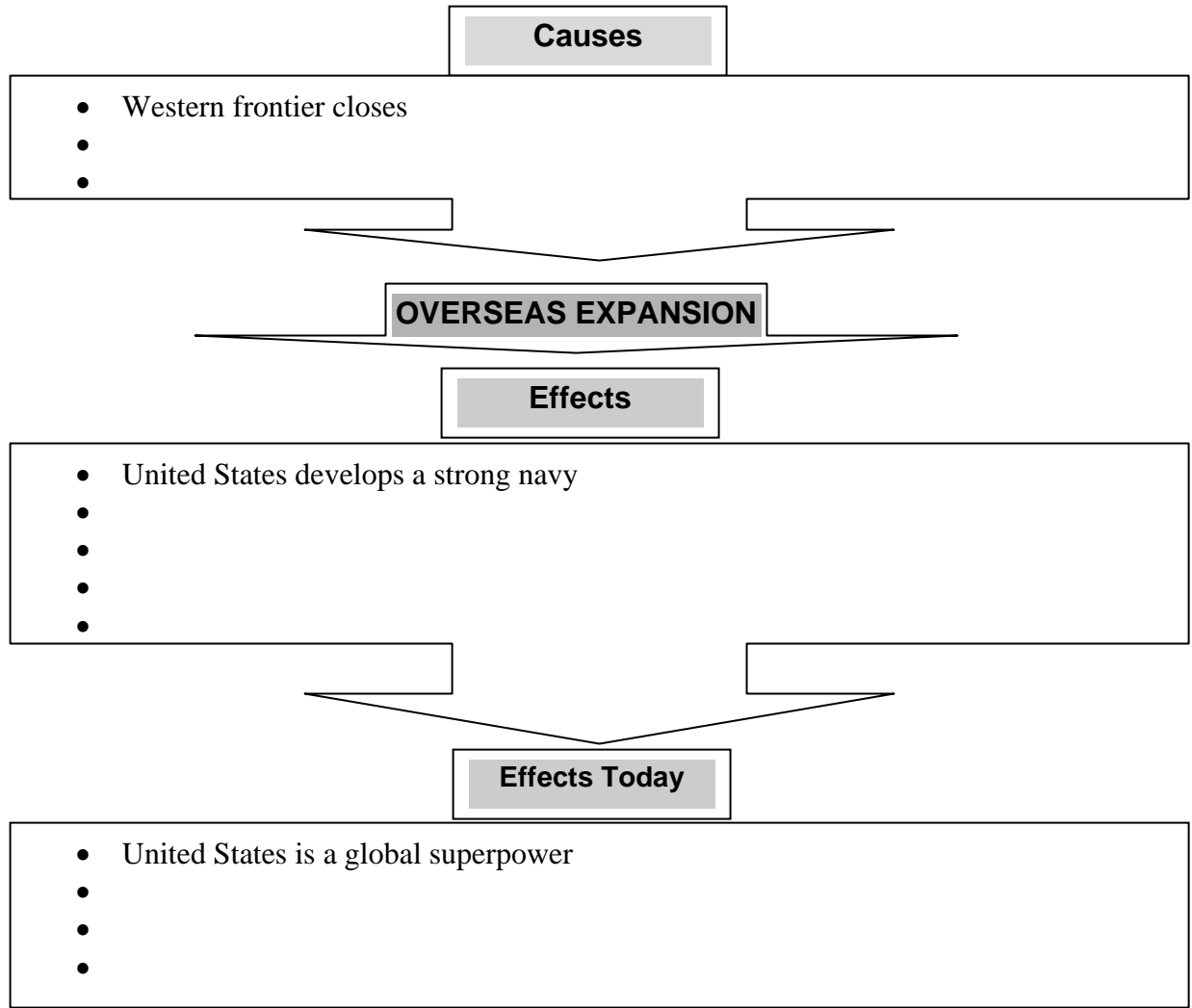


**Text Quest: U.S. Policies in Latin America (pages 675-680)**
